

# Ellie's Bonnet

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## Before you start

Always read the pattern thoroughly. Be aware of abbreviations that you do not know. You will find an explanation of all abbreviations on page 3.

The bonnet is crocheted in one piece and sewn together. The ch 2 in beginning of dc-rows counts as 1 dc.

## What you need

Crochet hook size 3,5 mm  
Yarn (see the section "Yarn")  
Scissors  
Yarn needle to weave in ends

## Yarn

I have chosen to use Drops Merino Ekstra Fine. It is so soft against your babies skin and keeps the little head warm.

Drops Merino Ekstra Fine  
Yardage : 50 gram = 105 meter

Materials:  
0-2 months: 30 gram  
3-6 months: 40 gram  
7-12 months: 50 gram  
Colour code: 16

Alternatives: Dale Lerke, Drops Cotton Merino or Mayflower Easy Care Classic.

## How to wash

Always wash according to the specific instructions for the yarn you use.

## Size guide

Size 0-2 months

Head circumference: 34-39 cm

Size 3-6 months

Head circumference: 39-43 cm

Size 7-12 months

Head circumference: 43-46 cm

## Gauge

21 dc x 5 r of alternately dc and sc = 10 x 10 cm på hæklenål  
3,5

Always make a test before you begin.

If the gauge does not match the specified crochet hook, try changing to a larger or smaller hook so that you find the hook with which you can achieve the specified gauge.

## Abbreviations

st: stitch

ch: chain

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

dc: double crochet

r: row

## Size 0-2 months

### **Bonnet**

Cut a piece of yarn, approx 30 cm. Save it for sewing the neck of the bonnet.

Ch 50

1. r: dc in 3. ch from hook, 1 dc in each st across, ch 1, turn (48)
2. r: 1 sc in each at across, ch 2, turn (48)
3. r: 1 dc in each st across, ch 1, turn (48)

4.-15. r: Repeat 2. and 3. r 7 times.

Do not fasten off.

### **Lace**

You are now working on the right side of the bonnet.

5 dc i 2 ch from hook, \*skip 1 st, 1 sc, skip 1 st, 5 dc\*.

Repeat from \* to \* until you have 2 st left. Skip 1 st, 1 sc.

Do not fasten off.

### **Sew together**

Sew right sides together at the neck using the piece of yarn you saved in the beginning.

Fasten off.

### **Strap**

Ch 50, sl st in 2. ch from hook, sl st in each st across - 48 st (49)

Work sc evenly around the edge of the neck of the bonnet. Be aware that on both sides of the hem you crochet 2 rows together twice - 4 rows becomes 2 of both sides.

Ch 50, sl st in 2. ch from hook, sl st in each st across - 48 st (49)

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

## Size 3-6 months

### Bonnet

Cut a piece of yarn, approx 30 cm. Save it for sewing the neck of the bonnet.

Ch 54

1. r: dc in 3. ch from hook, 1 dc in each st across, ch 1, turn (52)
2. r: 1 sc in each at across, ch 2, turn (52)
3. r: 1 dc in each st across, ch 1, turn (52)

4.-17. r: Repeat 2. and 3. r 8 times.

Continue like this:

18. r: 1 sc in each st across, ch 1, turn (52)
19. r: Repeat 18. r (52)

Do not fasten off.

### Lace

You are now working on the right side of the bonnet.

5 dc i 2 ch from hook, \*skip 1 st, 1 sc, skip 1 st, 5 dc\*.

Repeat from \* to \* until you have 2 st left. Skip 1 st, 1 sc.

Do not fasten off.

### Sew together

Sew right sides together at the neck using the piece of yarn you saved in the beginning.

Fasten off.

### Strap

Ch 52, sl st in 2. ch from hook, sl st in each st across - 50 st (51)

Work sc evenly around the edge of the neck of the bonnet. Be aware that on both sides of the hem you crochet 2 rows together twice - 4 rows becomes 2 of both sides.

Ch 52, sl st in 2. ch from hook, sl st in each st across - 50 st (51)

Fasten off and weave in all ends.

## Size 7-12 months

### **Bonnet**

Cut a piece of yarn, approx 40 cm. Save it for sewing the neck of the bonnet.

Ch 62

1. r: dc in 3. ch from hook, 1 dc in each st across, ch 1, turn (60)
2. r: 1 sc in each at across, ch 2, turn (60)
3. r: 1 dc in each st across, ch 1, turn (60)

Repeat 2. and 3. r 10 times.

Do not fasten off.

### **Lace**

You are now working on the right side of the bonnet.

5 dc i 2 ch from hook, \*skip 1 st, 1 sc, skip 1 st, 5 dc\*.

Repeat from \* to \* until you have 2 st left. Skip 1 st, 1 sc.

Do not fasten off.

### **Sew together**

Sew right sides together at the neck using the piece of yarn you saved in the beginning.

Fasten off.

### **Strap**

Ch 54, sl st in 2. ch from hook, sl st in each st across - 52 st (53)

Work sc evenly around the edge of the neck of the bonnet. Be aware that on both sides of the hem you crochet 2 rows together twice - 4 rows becomes 2 of both sides.

Ch 54, sl st in 2. ch from hook, sl st in each st across - 52 st (53)

Fasten off and weave in all ends.
